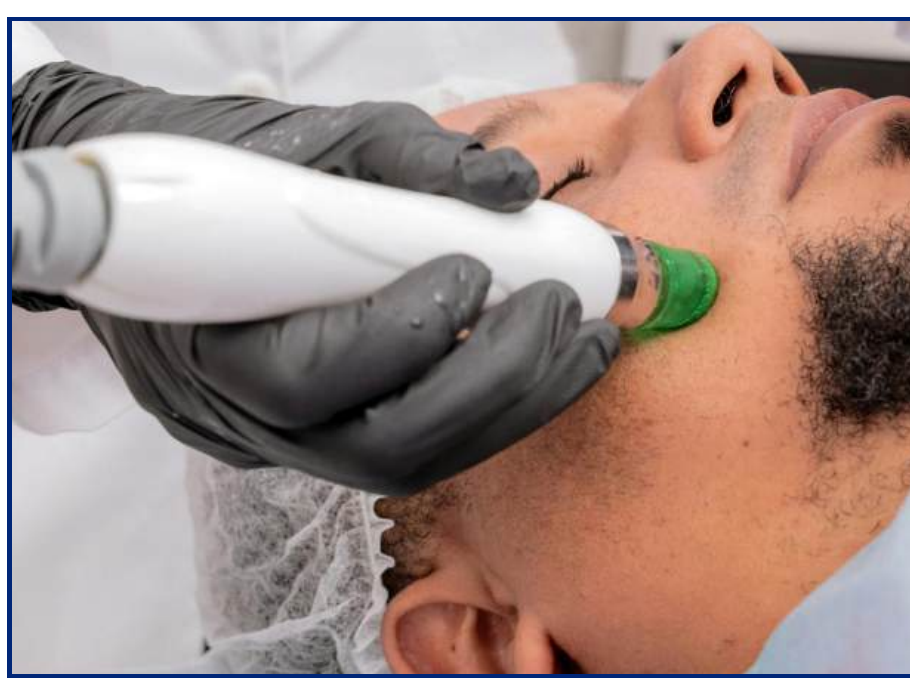
4. Bold Beard Styles

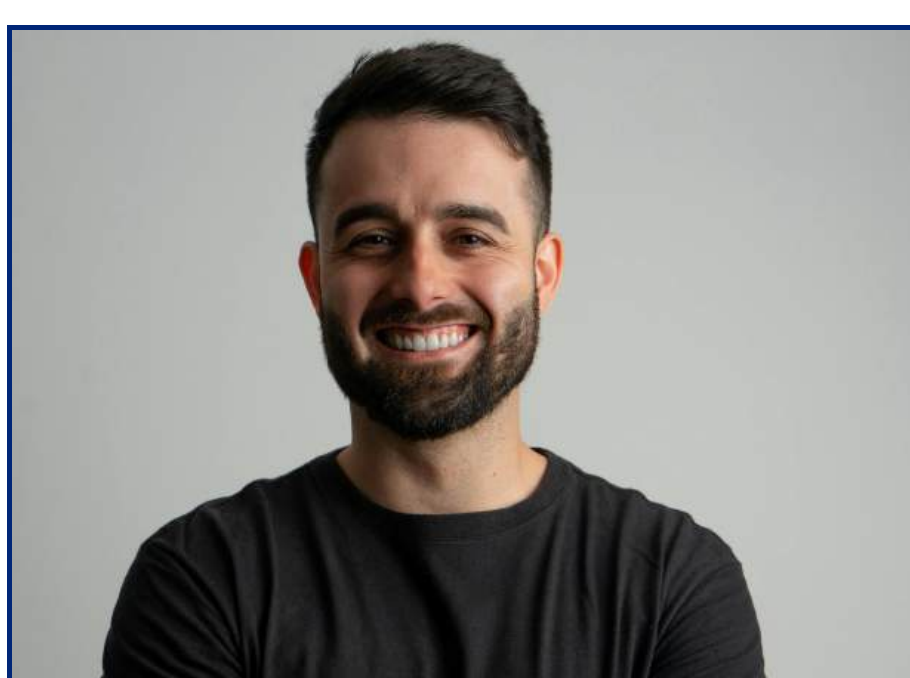
6. Gender Affirming Beard Styles Considerations
